During the nine years on Nokia's mobile site teams, worked with multiple internal organizations and incorporating their needs on the site itself or coming up with alternative ways for them to achieve their targets. In addition to site concept, other tasks involved consulting different Nokia teams on mobile web; keeping site up-to-date with current brand guidelines; ensuring performance in emerging markets while offering good user experience for developed markets; writing technical and brand guidelines for content production; assisting device and browser programs validate their products; creating prototypes and proof-of-concept demos both for web, mobile web and apps; compiling reports and analyzes on site usage for various parties.

All roles were global, including traveling and meetings in various Nokia locations with local colleagues and partners in addition to daily communications with people around the globe. In 2006 worked three months in Beijing with local companies on integration of local My Nokia to global backend.
